You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding proposed amendments to Chapter 4501:7-1 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) entitled "Licenses."

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements Section 107.54 of the Ohio Revised Code, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Private Investigation and Security Services Commission, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Section 107.52), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding the proposed amendments. Comments received during initial stakeholder outreach have been addressed in the Business Impact Analysis.
